Date: 14 – 17 Aug'17

DAY 1: 14 AUG, JOHANNESBURG / DRAKENSBERG

- Depart Pretoria University and travel per luxury coach to Champagne Sports Resort.
- Accommodation has been based on a 2 nights' stay at Champagne Sports Resort.
- Overnight at Champagne Sports Resort – dinner, bed and breakfast basis
